



## **USA GOLF Announces Men's Roster for Olympic Games Paris 2024**

*Team USA will be represented by World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler, defending gold medalist Xander Schauffele, Wyndham Clark and Collin Morikawa in Paris.*

**PONTE VEDRA BEACH, Florida** – USA GOLF announced the four men that will represent the United States at the Olympic Games Paris 2024, set for August 1-4 at Le Golf National.

As the top-four ranked Americans in the men's Olympic Golf Ranking, Scottie Scheffler (No. 1), Xander Schauffele (No. 3), Wyndham Clark (No. 5) and Collin Morikawa (No. 7) have each qualified to represent Team USA.

2020 Tokyo Olympic gold medalist Schauffele and Morikawa will represent Team USA at the Olympic Games for the second time in their careers, while World No. 1 Scheffler and Clark will make their debuts.

Golf will return to the Olympic Games for just the third time since 1904 after its return in 2016, with fields of 60 players for both men and women in a 72-hole stroke-play format at Le Golf National. Men's golf at the Olympic Games Paris 2024 will take place August 1-4, with the maximum four players allowed as all are ranked among the top 15 in the Olympic Golf Ranking.

"The United States is home to some of the best golfers in the world and it's an honor to introduce the four men that will represent Team USA on a global stage," said USA GOLF Executive Director Andy Levinson. "Since the return of golf to the Olympic Games, Team USA has reached the podium on both occasions with Matt Kuchar earning bronze in Rio and Xander Schauffele bringing home gold in Tokyo. With such a talented team going to Paris, we feel confident in Team USA's continued success."

### **Scottie Scheffler | Dallas, Texas**

- World No. 1 and FedExCup leader; has led the Official World Golf Ranking for 92 weeks (first: 3/27/2022)
- 11-time PGA TOUR winner and two-time Masters champion; has five wins on TOUR in 2024
- Won PGA TOUR Player of the Year honors back-to-back in 2022 and 2023
- Played for the victorious U.S. teams at the 2020 Ryder Cup and 2022 Presidents Cup
- Played collegiately at the University of Texas from 2014 to 2018, where he helped the team win three Big 12 championships and was named Phil Mickelson Freshman of the Year in 2015
- Member of U.S. Walker Cup Team in 2017

### **Xander Schauffele | San Diego, California**

- Won the gold medal at the men's golf competition at the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo
- Eight-time PGA TOUR winner, including first major at the 2024 PGA Championship
- Has 22 top-10s since the start of the 2022-23 PGA TOUR season, the second-most of any player in that span (29/Scheffler)
- Member of the victorious U.S. teams at the 2019, 2022 Presidents Cup, 2020 Ryder Cup
- 2017 PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year
- Played collegiately at San Diego State University and graduated in 2015

### **Wyndham Clark | Denver, Colorado**

- Three-time PGA TOUR winner, highlighted by the 2023 U.S. Open
- Has four top-10s on TOUR in 2024, including a win at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Represented the U.S. at the 2023 Ryder Cup
- Played collegiately at the University of Oregon and Oklahoma State University and earned Player of the Year awards in both conferences (Big 12/2014, Pac-12/2017)

### **Collin Morikawa | La Cañada, California**

- Six-time PGA TOUR winner, including major titles at The Open Championship and PGA Championship
- Won the 2021 DP World Tour Championship, becoming the first American to win the season-long Race to Dubai
- Represented the U.S. at the 2021 Ryder Cup and 2022 Presidents Cup
- Four time All-American at Cal where he reached the No. 1 spot in the World Amateur Golf Ranking and graduated in 2019

In Paris, both the men's and women's teams will be outfitted in a custom J.Lindeberg "Red, White, Blue for Gold" collection. J.Lindeberg is the Official Apparel Provider for USA GOLF for the upcoming two Olympic Games.
